Larry Male, age 18-30. Plays Tony, the Fry Cook in Fast Food. A little shy, and a little naive, but a very nice guy.

Jerry Male or Female, age 18-50. Plays Felix, the Manager in Fast Food. Nervous and usually the butt of any jokes.

Tina Female Age 18-30. Plays Lorraine, a Burger Buddy cashier in Fast Food. In love with Larry.

Adam Male, age 18-50. Plays a regular Customer at the Burger Buddy restaurant in Fast Food. Large, loud, happy, and constantly telling jokes.

Linda Female, age 18-30. Plays Wanda, Fast Food cashier who wants to be a nightclub singer. Young, pretty & constantly worrying over her make-up and costumes.

Bob Chuck, male or female age 18-50. Plays a homeless guy/gal who lives behind Burger Buddy and wears the onion Ring-Leader costume for promotions. A slob.

Dave Male or female age 18-50. Plays the Director of Fast Food. Calm, non-committal. Passes through green room once in awhile to encourage cast. Delivers 'drive-by' pep talks.

Mary Stage Manager. Frantic but well organized. A sort of Radar O'Rielly character.

Beth Male or female, age 18-50. Set Technician. Wanders through talking on her headset or chatting with the cast. Sort of bored looking, but always going somewhere.

Hunter & Clay Male, Ages 8 - 13. Hyperactive trouble makers.

Linda	Jeans, top. Puts on Burger Buddy Apron/hat during Act I. Changes into evening dress during Act II.
Bob	Act I Dirty jeans and t-shirt. Act II Onion-Ring-Leader costume. Act III bum costume.
Tina	Act I Jeans, top. Act II & III add Burger Buddy apron, hat.
Adam	Slacks & shirt
Hunter and Clay	Play clothes.
